Verification of Learning Disability

Weill Cornell Medicine-Qatar provides services and accommodations to person with disabilities to ensure equal access to educational programs and activities. To qualify for accommodations, a disability must *substantially limit* one or more major life activity, such as walking, hearing, speaking, seeing, learning, performing manual tasks, and working. Current and comprehensive disability documentation from an approved evaluator (who is not a relative of the student) is required before WCM-Q can make a determination. Additional documentation may be required. For additional information, see *Weill Cornell Medicine in Qatar Disability Accommodation*.

WCM-Q does not have a specific form to document a Learning Disability. Rather, the approved evaluator must submit documentation in accordance with the attached "Guidelines for Documenting a Learning Disability.

Reasonable accommodations will be determined by the WCM-Q Student Affairs Division based upon findings reported in the documentation provided by the student.
