**Dr. Albert Lowenfels** 

Emeritus Professor of Surgery Professor of Family Medicine New York Medical College USA Albert B. Lowenfels, MD is Emeritus Professor of Surgery, New York Medical College, Valhalla, NY, USA and also Professor of Family Medicine. He has published over 280 articles in peer-reviewed journals. He has been a reviewer for the Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA), British Medical Journal (BMJ), Nutrition and Cancer, Cancer Research, Pancreas, Gastroenterology. He is an Associate Editor of Pancreatology. His publications have been supported by the NIH and by the Smithers Foundation.

The focus of his research has been on disease prevention, the relationship between benign and malignant disease, pancreatic diseases, cystic fibrosis, infectious diseases, and health determinants of disease in Middle Eastern populations.
