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Dr. Tariq Chukir is an assistant professor of medicine at Weill Cornell Medicine-Qatar (WCM-Q) and an endocrinology consultant at the Qatar Metabolic Institute. He is the co-director of the Internal Medicine as well as the Anesthesia and Critical Care Clerkships at WCM-Q. Dr. Chukir's research interests include obesity, metabolic bone disorders, and medical education and is currently involved in several projects focusing on obesity medicine and medical education. Dr. Chukir has published several book chapters and papers in peer-reviewed journals. He has also contributed to the review of the national clinical guidelines in Qatar.

He received his M.D. degree from WCM-Q, followed by residency training in Internal Medicine at New York Presbyterian Hospital-Weill Cornell Medical Center (NYPH-WCM) and a fellowship in Endocrinology, Diabetes, and Metabolism at NYPH-WCM, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center and Hospital for Special Surgery in New York. He is American board certified in Internal Medicine, Endocrinology, Obesity Medicine and Clinical Lipidology.
