PRECISION MEDICINE: FUTURE OR FAD?

The National Research Council defines Precision Medicine as, "the ability to classify individuals into subpopulations that differ in their susceptibility to a particular disease, the biology and prognosis of those diseases they may develop, or their response to a specific treatment." Physicians use genetic and environmental data to tailor diagnosis and treatment to specific individuals and subpopulations in precision medicine. However, critics argue that precision medicine is simply another healthcare fad that will fail to provide tangible benefits beyond currently available treatments. In your own words, write an 800-word essay presenting your views on the potential of precision medicine to improve health in Qatar.
