Past roles include Chair of mental health services in Qatar, Chair of the Middle East Division of the Royal College of Psychiatrists, Qatar's representative to the WHO-EMRO region and the GCC council for mental health, executive roles in Arab Board and Arab Federation of Psychiatrists and zonal representative for the Middle East at World Psychiatric Association. She continues to be involved with the WHO and World Federation for Mental Health on various projects, guidelines and position statements.
