She also co-leads the Point of Care Ultrasound Curriculum at WCM-Q. Dr Rizvi is a Consultant in the Medical Intensive Care Unit at Hamad Medical Corporation. She is American Board Certified in Internal Medicine, Nephrology, and Critical Care Medicine.

An alumna of WCM-Q, Dr. Rizvi completed her residency training in Internal Medicine at Rochester General Hospital in Western New York where she was recognized with the Dr. U.C. Nigwekar Scholarship award for fostering the spirit of scholarship during residency. She then completed fellowships in Nephrology and Critical Care at University of Rochester Medical Center and Mayo Clinic, Rochester, respectively.

Throughout the years, Dr Rizvi has been a passionate and firm advocate for improving medical education to promote an easy, inquisitive environment, with the goal of improving patient outcomes. She has several peer-reviewed publications in areas of medical education as well as critical care medicine. She has presented at various regional, national, and international platforms.
