Dr. Jyotishman Pathak

Professor of Population Health Sciences Population Health Sciences Weill Cornell Medicine, Cornell University New York, USA Dr. Pathak is the Frances & John L. Loeb Professor of Medical Informatics, Chief of the Division of Health Informatics, and Vice Chair for Entrepreneurship in the Department of Population Health Sciences at Weill Cornell Medicine, Cornell University, New York. His research focuses on secondary uses of electronic health records (EHRs) and insurance claims data, and clinical decision support for improving mental and behavioral health

This work has been funded by multiple major national grants from the U.S. National Institutes of Health (NIH), the Veterans Health Administration (VHA), the National Science Foundation (NSF), the Agency of Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ), the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (AFSP), Merck Pharmaceuticals, and several private foundations. Dr. Pathak has published over 250 papers including many book chapters and invited reviews.

He is also the Founder of Iris OB Health Inc. – a mental health startup spun out of Cornell developing artificial intelligence technology for early detection and prevention of postpartum depression and anxiety. Dr. Pathak is a Fellow of the American College of Medical Informatics, and received his Ph.D. in Computer Science from Iowa State University, Ames (2007) and a B.Engg. in Computer Engineering from the National Institute of Technology, India (2002).
