Weill Cornell Medical College in Qatar (WCMC-Q) is a regional center for the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT). Prospective medical students interested in applying for American and Canadian Medical Colleges have to sit for the MCAT in order to be considered for admission. For the Gulf region, the test will take place on August 20 at the premises of the WCMC-Q in Education City, Doha- Qatar.
